

Inventory Merge - Which Part Is Master

The inventory record that was **last sold** is considered the master record. When we merge two parts with the same part number, the values for the following fields are accumulated into the values in the Master record: Total Cost, On Hand, On Order, Committed, Core Quantity, Month-to-Date Quantity, Month-to-date Sales, Year-to-date Quantity, Year-to-date Sales, and the Monthly quantity for 12 months. In addition, any parts on open orders or open purchase orders are updated with the new line code. There are a number of fields that are not affected. **This was done with the assumption that the Master record, which was created more recently, has correct values.**
